IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES APPEARING FOR PRELIMINARY TRIALS UNDER ECA ADMISSIONS – 2019-20

- In case there is an overlap/clash of trial dates for candidates appearing in multiple categories/sub-categories, candidates are required to appear ON PRIORITY for the trial/s that is/are being held for <u>lesser</u> number of days. In such cases, candidates are also <u>mandatorily</u> required to inform the Convener of the relevant Categories <u>in advance</u>.
- 2. In case any <u>outstation</u> candidate (residing outside the NCR) has a trial slot on 25th or 26th June 2019 and is unable to reach the venue for trials on these dates, he/she is required to reach the trial venue at the earliest date (preferably on 27th June) and contact the Registration Desk of the relevant Category at the trial venue. This is applicable **ONLY** for those **OUTSTATION** candidates whose trials are scheduled on 25th and 26th June 2019. This option is **NOT AVAILABLE** for candidates whose trials are scheduled for any other dates for a category or for those categories for which trials are scheduled for a single day.
- 3. The time schedule for Registration and Trials for all Categories (except Creative Writing, Quiz and Fine Arts) is as follows:

- 5. Candidates are advised to check the results of Preliminary Trials on 6th July 2019 on the DU website. These candidates will have been shortlisted for the Final Trials commencing on 9 July 2019.
- 6. Candidates are mandatorily required to carry the following documents with them when they appear for the trials:
 - Photocopy of DU registration receipt with registration number
 - Photo identification ID proof recognized by the Government of India (the photograph of the candidate should be clearly visible)

NOTE: Hard copies of the above documents are required. Digital copies would not be accepted.

All candidates are strongly advised to go through the Detailed Guidelines for Preliminary Trials for their relevant Category/Sub-Category available on the DU website. Strict adherence to these guidelines is mandatory during the trials.
