Q.1 What courses are available in the college?

Ans.1 There are eleven courses available in the college as given below:

Q.7 Whether students from streams other than science can take admission in the college?

Ans.7 The students of streams other than science course can take admission only in B.Sc. (Hons.) Computer Science for which mathematics is compulsory as a subject. The detailed procedure of admission to the course is available on the college web site www.bcas.du.ac.in.

Q.8 Whether the admission forms and payment can be made online?

Ans.8 From the academic year 2016-2017 admissions are being done online and fees is also being received online. The details in this regard are provided at the University of Delhi website www.du.ac.in from time to time

Q.9 Whether gap year students can take admission in the college?

Ans.9 The admission of the gap year students are considered according to the admission rules of University of Delhi.

Q.10 What is the minimum age of entry to the college?

Ans.10 There is no minimum age of entry to the college, as per the norms of the University of Delhi.

Q.11.What is the last date for refund of fees and the procedure for the same?
